

Roll Off Service Agreement

Terms and Conditions of the Roll Off Service Agreement:

1. Container Fee:

10 Cubic Yards = \$410 up to 1 ton

15 Cubic Yard = \$520 up to 2 ton

20 Cubic Yards = \$600 up to 3 ton

30 Cubic Yards = \$650 up to 4 ton

40 Cubic Yards= \$865 up to 6 ton

** An overweight fee of \$125 per ton will apply to all loads that weigh more than the above specified weight limits for each container and will be billed to your credit card.

2. Rental Term:

Container rental is for (14) days only, unless prior arrangements are made. You will be charged \$10 +Tax per day after the 14th day of rental. Please call CRP Sanitation, Inc. when the container is ready for pick up at (914) 592-4129.

3. Overloading:

Customer agrees not to load the container above water level. Any debris loaded above the top of the container is a hazard and must be off-loaded before the container is picked up.

4. Moving Container:

Container is not to be moved by anything other than a CRP Sanitation truck. Customer is responsible for any damages that result from a moved container.

5. Blocked Location:

If CRP Sanitation arrives to deliver or pick up a container and the location is blocked by a vehicle, debris, or anything that prevents the driver from delivering or picking up the container, there will be a Trip Charge of \$175 for each trip attempt.

6. Homeowners Multiple Containers:

This is a blanket service agreement that covers all containers ordered for this job site.

7. Contractors:

This is a blanket service agreement that covers all containers ordered for the named contractor.

8. Liability:

CRP Sanitation, Inc. will not be held responsible for any damage resulting from the delivery, placement, or pick-up of containers. Contractors agree to hold harmless CRP Sanitation from third party claims made by homeowners.

9. Dirt, Rock, Concrete and Blacktop:

Please be advised that these materials weigh on average over 1 ton per cubic yard. If mixed in containers in any proportion they will cause containers to go overweight. A 10yd container can easily weigh 10 tons with the above materials mixed in. Under the above pricing structure, a 10yd container can easily cost over \$1,500. See clause #1. If you have large quantities of the above material ask a sales rep for the best way to dispose of these materials.
